

Is Polyurethane Required?

What is Polyurethane?

Polyurethane acts as a shield for your cork floors. It protects the cork from the scratches and spills that come with everyday life and enhance the lifespan of your floors.

Why is it required?

To ensure your floor last for years to come, we recommend coating your cork floors with Loba 2k Supra AT water based polyurethane. This allows the floor to expand and contract as one piece and not individual planks. This prevents the floor from damaging on the edges of the planks or tiles. This also helps to prevent water from penetrating into the seams and causing water damage to the locking system or further wearing away at seams of the cork.
